### ADVENT RECONCILIATION



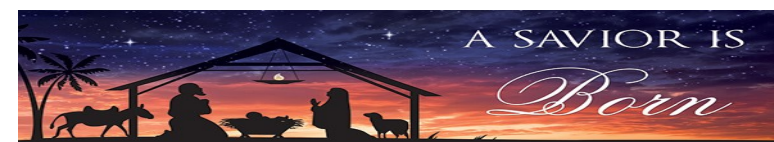
We will not have a common 'Second Rite of

### LIMIT ON CONGREGATION SIZE FOR OUR CHRISTMAS MASSES

To comply with the State Government's revised  
requirements on the size of congregations at  
places of worship our maximum permitted  
congregation size at any mass (including  
Christmas masses) is 422 people. Where it is  
considered appropriate, numbers will be  
monitored as people enter the Church to ensure  
the maximum congregation size is not exceeded.  
Social distancing requirements also apply.  
Individuals must continue to maintain physical  
distancing between themselves and people of  
other households.

The mass where congregation size might be an  
issue is the Children's / Family mass at 7pm on  
Christmas Eve, so we ask that those of us not  
attending mass with children / young families con-  
sider attending one of the three other Christ-  
mas masses.

appreciated.



### Angels' Candle

fourth Sunday of Advent.
