WEEKLY BLESSED SACRAMENT ADORATION

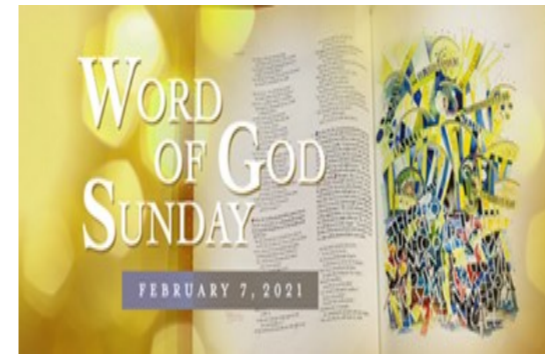
