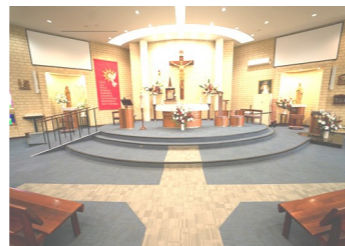

Thank you.

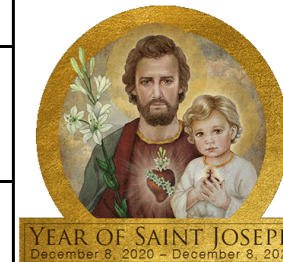
### GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION 2021

#### DIRECTIVES FROM ARCHDIOCESE OF PERTH

Dear parishioners, please see directives prepared by the  
Archdiocese of Perth and with reference to the WA  
Government regulations and recommendations pertaining  
to COVID-19 pandemic.

**Palm Sunday** - Please take the palm crosses home, do not  
leave them in the foyer.

**Holy Thursday**—The ceremony of the Washing of the Feet  
will be reduced to four people only and all requirements will  
be followed.

**Procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of  
Repose**—We will have the Altar of Repose after Mass for  
silent prayer. Please observe physical distancing .

#### Good Friday

**Stations of the Cross**—This will be held outside the Church.  
Please observe physical distancing and other government  
requirements. Please take the prayer sheets home.

**Celebration of the Passion of the Lord**—Please observe  
physical distancing and other government requirements.

**Adoration of the Cross**—There will be no touching or kissing  
of the Cross. The Cross will be held high while people remain  
in their places, pause in contemplation of the cross.

**Easter Vigil**—A small group of people will be present at the  
blessing of the Easter Fire, while the rest of the congregation  
waits in the Church.

**Easter Sunday**—Please observe all COVID-19 government  
requirements .
