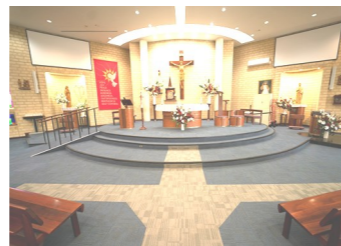

Parish, 392 Albert Street, Balcatta. The Catechism of  
the Catholic Church emphasises the importance of
