If you are new to our parish, we invite you to complete the Visitors Book in the foyer.

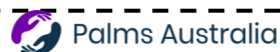

10 Mar - 12 Mar BENEDICTINE EXPERIENCE WEEKEND

B'tine spirituality is more readily experienced than defined. These weekends in the monastery Guest-house (beginning with Vespers at 6.30pm on Friday, concluding after lunch on Sunday) provide the opportunity to enter fully into the monastic rhythm and balance of prayer, work, *lectio divina*, hospitality and community life. There will be opportunities to ponder the riches of the scriptures and monastic literature, both in group discussions and personal silence and solitude, bringing from the 'storeroom, things both new and old.'

Participants are also invited to join the community for silent meals in the refectory, one of many invitations to listen with the 'ear of the heart.'

Cost \$300 (includes accommodation, meals and entry into the Museum and Art Gallery).
