

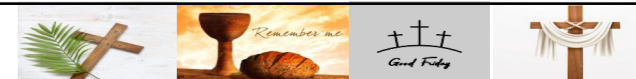

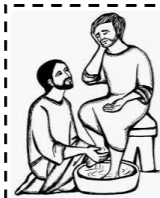
If you are new to our parish, we invite you to complete the Visitors Book in the foyer.

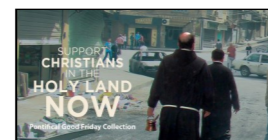
### WASHING OF FEET

**We require 12 volunteers to have their feet washed at Mass on Holy Thursday evening.**

The washing of feet is a significant component of the Mass of the Lord's Supper:

*"In the act of washing the soiled feet of our humanity, Jesus is leading us from slavery of selfishness to the establishment and freedom of a new way of relating founded on humble, loving service."*

### GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION

The annual collection for the support of the church in the Holy Land takes place on Good Friday. This collection promotes the missionary work of the Church in the Holy Land by providing welfare assistance to local Christians in areas such as health, education, employment and housing. ### Holy Week Schedule—St Luke's Parish, Woodvale

#### What is Holy Week & Easter Triduum?

Holy Week stands at the head of our calendar, the holiest week of the entire liturgical year. Holy Week begins on Palm Sunday and continues until Easter Sunday. It celebrates the Paschal Mystery, the passion and death of our Lord, Jesus Christ, and his victorious resurrection, his triumph over sin and death and his glorification by his Father.

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are: Mass of the Lord's Supper, Good Friday of the Lord's Passion and the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord.
