DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY



Feast of Divine Mercy. Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when **"all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened"** (Diary of St Faustina ['Diary'] 699).

Jesus promised that **"The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment"** (Diary 699).

This is also a day we venerate the image of the Divine Mercy of Our Lord Our God who said to St Faustina **"I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish."** (Diary 341, 48).

Please take the time to visit with the image of The Divine Mercy and venerate Jesus. A print of the image is located on the western wall of our church, to the left of the statue of St Luke.
