Safeguarding Induction for all Church workers

PENTECOST SUNDAY
PARISH CONFIRMATION MASSES

On Pentecost Sunday, the Parish will also celebrate the Confirmation of 67 Parish candidates. There will be two Confirmation Masses over this weekend. On Saturday, 27th May at the 6:00pm Mass, 34 candidates and their families will be attending Mass. On Sunday, 28th May at the 9:30am Mass, 33 candidates and their families will be attending Mass. The Sunday, May 28th 8:00am and Sunday, May 28th 6:00pm Masses, will be the regular Pentecost Mass celebration. Due to the larger numbers at the two Confirmation Masses and reserved seating for; the candidates, sponsors and family members, the partitions will be opened and extra seating organised.

As Parishioners of St Luke's Church, we are called to bear witness to the Confirmation of these students as they become fully initiated into our Catholic community. As our Church becomes filled with the Holy Spirit in a special way through the Confirmation Rite, we might all reflect on the gifts — **Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel (Right Judgement), Fortitude (Courage), Knowledge, Piety (Reverence), and Fear of God (Wonder and Awe)** - and fruits - **love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (Gal 5:22-23)** - that the coming of the Holy Spirit continually seeks to bring into our own lives.
