### Safeguarding Induction for all Church workers

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has broadened safeguarding to include adults at risk. ALL church workers (volunteers or paid) are to attend a 1-hour safeguarding induction. A church worker is **anyone** in the parish in **any role** — paid or voluntary. **If you haven't attended the induction in the last 3 years, please register for the upcoming session.** This induction provides an overview of the Safeguarding Policies and Procedures, the role of the Parish Safeguarding Officer, and importance of Safeguarding within the parish.
