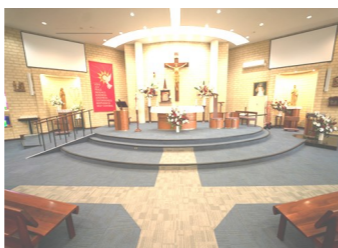

### ST LUKE'S ANNUAL COUNCIL MEETING 2023



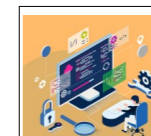
St Luke's Annual Council Meeting will be held on Sunday 27th August in the Parish hall after the 9:30m Mass.

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has broadened safeguarding to include adults at risk. ALL church workers (volunteers or paid) are to attend a 1-hour safeguarding induction.
