FEAST OF BLESSED FRANCIS MARY OF THE CROSS JORDAN



Father Francis Jordan was born on 16 June 1848 in Gurtweil, a small town in the archdiocese of Freiburg (Germany). After ordination to the priesthood on 21 July 1878, he was sent to Rome, where he spent most part of his life. He founded the Society of the Divine Savior (Salvatorians) in 1881 and the Congregation of the Sisters of the Divine Savior (Salvatorian Sisters) in 1888. He died on 8 September 1918 in Tafers in Switzerland. Beatified in Rome on 15 May 2021.
