First Eucharist – PARISH MASSES

Due to the larger numbers at the two First Eucharist Masses and reserved seating for the candidates, sponsors and family members, the partitions will be opened and extra seating organised.

As Parishioners of St Luke's Church, we are called to bear witness to these students as they receive the special gift of Jesus through the Eucharist for the first time. These children will become one with Jesus in a new way, joined more deeply to the Body of Christ, His Church.
