ADVENT SYMBOLS—MEANING

Floral Arrangements: Traditionally, the general rule has been no altar flowers during Advent. This is because it is a solemn season of preparation for Christmas. Here at St Luke's the floral arrangements reflect the season's penitential nature as also can be seen in its liturgical colour, which is violet.

Symbolism of the Advent Wreath Candles: Set on the branches of the Advent wreath are four candles: three purple candles and one pink candle. A more modern tradition is to place a white candle in the centre of the wreath. As a whole, these coloured advent candles rworld.epresent the coming of the light of Christ into the

Each week of Advent on Sunday, a particular Advent candle is lit. Catholic tradition states that the four candles, representing the four weeks of Advent, each stand for one thousand years, to total the 4,000 years from the time of Adam and Eve til the birth of the Saviour.

Prophecy Candle: On the first Sunday of Advent, the first purple candle is lit. This candle is typically called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, primarily Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ:

Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel. Isaiah 7:14, ents hope or expectation in anticipation of the coming Messiah. FROM THE LITURGY COMMITTEE
