the reflections at home.

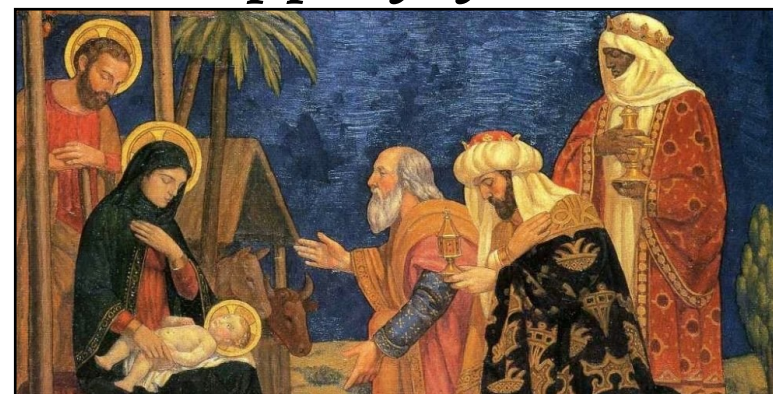
The second sheet is for those who would like to be part of a

ADULT FAITH FORMATION

Many Catholics want to read the Bible because they know it
is God's Word, but they give up because it seems so
complicated. *Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible* helps you get
