If you would like to journey together in a Lenten Discussion Program please make sure you enter your details on the sheets in the foyer, so that we can order the required number of Lenten Program Books.




There are 3 sheets in the fover. One is if you would like to do the reflections at home.

### **ADULT FAITH FORMATION**
