### ASH WEDNESDAY—14 FEBRUARY 2024

**MASSES AT 9:00AM AND 7:00PM**

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. The law of fasting binds those who have completed 18 years, until the beginning of their 60th year; the law of abstinence binds those who are over 14 years of age.

**There will be two Masses on this day at 9:00am and 7:00pm.**

**Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament after the Mass, until 3:00pm.**

World Day of the Sick is observed on February 11th each year. This was introduced by Pope John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses.
